

Finally, health insurance benefits for your small business employees.



It's new, it's affordable, and it was created specifically for Arkansas' small businesses. It's called ARHealthNet—an insurance program that helps qualified small businesses provide an affordable package of health care benefits to their employees.

Additionally, premiums for employees who meet certain income requirements will be subsidized; for example, a family of three with income up to \$34,340 or a family of four with income up to \$41,300 will receive the subsidy.

Who qualifies:

ARHealthNet is available to businesses with 2 to 500 employees who have not offered a group health plan in the past 12 months or longer. The plan is only available to working Arkansans through qualified employers and is not available as an individual plan.

The benefits:

The program provides the following benefits:

- 7 inpatient days per year
- 2 major outpatient services per year, including emergency room and major services performed in the office
- 6 physician office visits per year
- 2 prescriptions per month
- maximum annual benefit of \$100,000
- renewable each 12 months
